Application procedures

- All applicants must read the guidelines carefully before application, and submit three sets of the following documents to the Embassy of Japan by the deadline. One set is required to be original documents, and the other two sets may be photocopies thereof.

 - ✓ Field of Study and Research Program Plan
 - √ 2 passport size photos
 - ✓ Academic transcript of each academic year of the last university attended
 - ✓ Graduation certificate or degree certificate of the last university attended
 - ✓ Recommendation letters from the principal or adviser of the last university attended
 - ✓ Recommendation letter from the present employer (if currently employed)
 - ✓ Medical certificate
 - ✓ Abstracts of thesis
