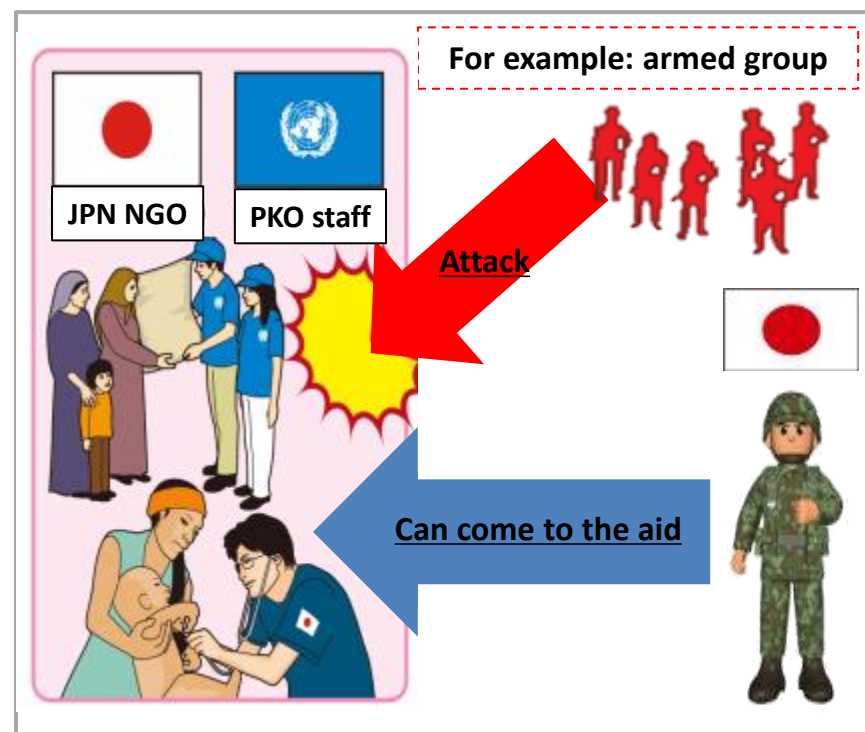


Coming to the Aid of PKO-Related Individuals

Primary responsibility of Japan Engineering Unit continues to be engineering and construction work in and around Juba.

Outline of task

- FOR WHOM: individuals engaging in UN peacekeeping operations or individuals providing support for those operations (“PKO-related individuals”)
- WHEN: unexpected dangers to lives or bodies of such individuals occur or are imminent
- HOW: upon urgent request
- WHAT: Japan Engineering Unit can come to the aid of said individuals in coordination with UNMISS
- CONDITIONS:
 - When no local security forces or other PKO units are available to respond quickly
 - Only within limited capability of Japan Engineering Unit; Task is a temporary and emergency measure conducted due to humanitarian and urgent nature of the request for help.



Joint Protection of Camps

Primary responsibility of Japan Engineering Unit on UNMISS Tongping Camp continues to be protecting its own area.

Outline of task

- WHEN: UNMISS Tongping Camp (where Japan Engineering Unit and other countries' UNMISS units are co-located) comes under attack
- WHAT: Japan Engineering Unit can jointly protect other UNMISS units inside entire UN camp, within the Japan Unit's capability
- PROS: Participating in joint exercises for joint protection of camps will also facilitate communication and cooperation with other PKO units in case of emergency, contributing to enhancing the security of the camp as a whole.
- LIMITATIONS: Only within the limited capability of Japan Engineering Unit
