





Food security crisis response assistance in 2017

Emergency food distribution and nutritional fortification for IDPs through **WFP** [\$4.2 million]

Emergency health and non-food item intervention for IDPs through **IOM** [\$1 million]

Emergency health emergency operations for the most vulnerable through **ICRC** [\$1 million]

Prevention of nutritional crisis for refugee communities in Upper Nile through **UNHCR** [\$1 million]

Earlier, Japan has made available \$22.4 million for humanitarian and reconstruction assistance. Japan's aggregate assistance to South Sudan since the December 2013 crisis adds up to approximately USD 196.2 million.
